The OPA Free Medical Camp

The Free Medical Camp organized by the OPA was concluded successfully on 14th July 2024. Under the keen supervision of OPA past president Eng. Shantha Senarath and his able team, the program started sharp at 7.30 am with a sumptuous breakfast, followed by the welcome and introductory speeches.

The medical camp then promptly started at 8.30 am and the participants availed themselves to 4 different sections as mentioned below.

- 1. The Medical section organized by IMPA offered blood sugar screening, BMI assessment and BP assessment, followed by individual consultations by doctors with hardly any waiting time. The Screening was done by the Suwa Diviya team, a non profit initiative for Diabetes prevention. 65 people were screened. Approximately 55 consultations were done by the team of IMPA member doctors comprising, Dr Priyadhashini Samarasinghe, Dr. Ruchira Jalthota, Dr Sabith Sallieh, Dr. Rasarie Wimalana and Dr Kayathri Periasamy. We were ably assisted by the members of Nursing Institute.
- 2. Health Awareness Section was a new introduction this





time, a brainchild of Dr Kanthi Ariyaratne. Members of the Health Promotion Bureau led by Dr Uthpala Amarasinghe, were able to provide much needed education about non communicable diseases and their prevention through lifestyle changes, and prevention and control of communicable diseases, vaccination, stress management. As the groups were small each time a whole range of topics were discussed according to the participants' needs and was hailed as a "much needed entity" by the Past President of the OPA himself, who also participated.

- 3. The Eye section was managed by HelpAge, whose mobile unit was equipped with vision assessment, and cataract screening.
- The Dental Section was managed by the National Dental Institute of the Health Ministry, and they performed dental assessments and filling when needed.

Overall, the Medical Camp was well attended and ran smoothly and provided much needed relief for those who attended, who were mostly aged 50 to 75 years old.

Health tips

To All Marketing Authorization Holders of Medicines

Regulatory Strengthening of Controls on Falsified Products

The Board of the National Medicines Authority has decided to implement the following changes to the labeling requirements of medicines in order to enhance protection against falsified products coming into the market.

Sticker to be placed on each commercial pack indicating the wordings 'NMRA approved'
and the number of the NMRA registration certificate in legible fonts. The sticker indicating
the retail price of the product shall be used. A specimen is given below as an example:

Retail Price: Rs. XXX.00 NMRA approved Reg. No. M XXXXXXFR

The sticker shall be implemented immediately for any consignments released to the market with effect from 1st August 2024. The batches already released to market are not affected by this decision.

2. Product specific QR code or bar code of the manufacturer.

QR code or bar code on each commercial pack will be made compulsory after a grace period of three months from today. The following information should be accessible through the code:

- The product name
- · The generic name and strength
- Batch number
- · Date of manufacture
- Date of expiry
- · Price of the product
- Name of the manufacture and site address

We expect your fullest corporation to implement these controls and help prevention of falsified products getting into the market.
